Check in/NPIP/State Inspection

State Inspectors will be on-site for blood testing on Friday evening from 4PM – 8PM and on Saturday from 6AM – 9AM. No birds will be allowed in the arena without being blood tested or the presentation of current and valid NPIP documentation. If you have an NPIP certified flock, you must bring documentation of testing (NPIP card or testing documents) with you, or your birds will need to be tested prior to admission to the show. No exceptions.

It is recommended that exhibitors arrive early (Friday Evening) or beginning at 6AM on Saturday if your birds need to be tested. Please do not wait until the last minute to have this done.

Failure to check in with the state inspectors and the show secretary prior to bringing birds into the arena may result in disqualification from the show. Anyone bringing a bird onto the show grounds, even if they are for sale and not being entered in the show, must follow the bio-security rules listed on the rules page.

Any birds showing any signs of illness will be promptly removed from the Showroom. No Exceptions.

NOTE: WE WILL NOT ACCEPT ANY ENTRIES FROM STATES WITH CONFIRMED CASES OF AVIAN INFLUENZA (AI) WITHOUT DOCUMENTATION OF FLOCK TESTING.

Entry Fees

Open Poultry Show: \$6.00 per entry

Youth Poultry Show: \$3.50 per entry

Showmanship fee: \$1 if showing poultry at this show.

Limited Double Cooping for oversize large fowl birds available at \$9.00 per open entry and \$5.00 per youth entry (please indicate on entry form)

There will be a \$5 set-up/clean up fee charged per exhibitor.

Egg Show (any class or section): \$2.00 per entry

An entry consists of either three (3) eggs entered in either the Main Egg Section or one (1) egg in the Painted/Decorated Egg Section. Entries in each section requires a separate entry form to be submitted. Egg show entries are not subject to the \$5 clean up fee. Refer to the Egg Show section of this show catalog for details.

If you are entering in multiple shows/sections (Open Poultry, Junior Poultry, Open Egg Main Section, Open Egg Painted/Decorated Section, Junior Egg Main Section, Junior Egg Painted/Decorated Section) please ensure that each entry is on a separate entry form.

Payment may be made by check, money order or via PayPal (including Credit/Debit cards, which will be processed via PayPal). Checks and money orders should be made payable to CFPBA.

Payments via PayPal (or Credit/Debit Cards, which will be processed via PayPal) will be charged a \$0.30 fee per exhibitor (youth or open), plus \$0.20 per bird for open entries and \$0.10 per bird for youth entries. These fees are to cover the PayPal transaction fees. If paying via the online form and paying via PayPal, please be sure to select “PayPal” as the method of payment or you may be required to pay the fees at the show upon check-in.

Refunds will not be given for birds or eggs that are not brought to the show.

Entries received prior to that date will be returned.

Mail-in entries must be postmarked by 11:59 pm, Friday, October 19, 2018.

E-mail and online entries will be accepted until 10:00 pm, Monday, October 22, 2018.

Entries will not be considered as accepted until payment is made. Call-ins will not be accepted without prior arrangements.

A verification e-mail (or phone call for those with no e-mail) will be made upon the processing of the entry. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to make sure they have an entry confirmation number prior to show day. This is not your exhibitor number; those will be given out at check-in.

Sale Pens

Sale pens will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. The cost is \$2.00 for exhibitors, \$5.00 for non-exhibitors per sales pen. A maximum of three (3) birds are allowed per cage. Limited spaces either indoors or outdoors (if available) will be available for \$10.00 each for exhibitors, \$25.00 each for non-exhibitors, and will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Animal sales will only be allowed in approved areas. Setting up for sales in the parking lot or outside of the arena is strictly forbidden.

Vendors will be given space to set up inside. We request all vendors donate an item to the raffle table.

Egg Show

Our first Egg Show will be held at the 2018 Citrus Classic. The Egg Show has both Open and Junior divisions. The Junior division is broken down by the following age classes for the Painted and Decorated Sections only (please be sure to mark exhibitor's age on the entry form):

- 7 and under (Pee-Wee) ("champions" get a "goodie bag")
- Ages 8-10 (Junior)
- Ages 11-13 (Intermediate)
- Ages 14-18 (Senior)

An Egg Show exhibitor does not have to be entered in the Open or Junior poultry show. The "Proposed APA Egg Competition Standard" shall be used as a basis for the Egg Show rules and for judging. Ribbons shall be awarded to the champions. The following are the judging categories for the Egg Show:

Main Egg Section

A group of three (3) eggs shall be entered per entry. These eggs shall be judged externally based on color, shape, shell texture, freshness, bloom, appearance, matching and uniformity. The eggs shall also be judged internally (one egg shall be broken) based on yolk, albumen, chalazae, and airspace.

When entering, please mark on the entry form the egg class: Large Eggs, Bantam Eggs, Waterfowl Eggs, or Non-Standard Eggs (this includes mixed breeds, birds of unknown ancestry and birds outside of the APA Standard of Perfection). If the breed and color are known, they should also be noted on the entry form.

Painted Egg Section

A single egg shall be entered per entry. The egg size must be noted on the entry form (Chicken, Goose, Duck, Guinea or Turkey). The Painted Egg Standard is as follows:

1. Entry must be hard-boiled or blown.
2. Egg to be painted or inked.
3. No decoration may be applied.
4. Some type of upright support is recommended for display.
5. Egg MUST be painted or inked by the exhibitor.

Decorated Egg Section

A single egg shall be entered per entry. The egg size must be noted on the entry form (Chicken, Goose, Duck, Guinea or Turkey). The Decorated Egg Standard is as follows:

1. Entry must be hard-boiled or blown.
2. Decorated egg may also be painted. Examples of adornment are beads, colored paper, shells, plant materials, etc.
3. Whatever the design chosen, the outline of the egg must be maintained; its shape always being recognizable.
4. Egg decoration MUST be created by the exhibitor.

Silent Auction (depending on availability of donations)

During the show there will be a silent auction with the proceeds to support the club. Several high quality pairs of birds of different breeds donated by top breeders will be auctioned. For more information see any show staff member the day of the show.

Concession Stand

There will be a concession stand open starting around noon. An announcement will be made when it is open as to the location and the food being available for purchase.

Raffle Table

A raffle table with the proceeds to support the club will be present at the front of the stage with donations from various people and vendors. For more information see any show staff member the day of the show.

Rest Rooms

Rest rooms are available at the show.

Show Set-up and Tear Down

We are asking for assistance with set up on Friday, October 26th, from 9:00 am until 5:00 pm, and tear down immediately following the show on Saturday, October 27th. Any help that can be provided would be greatly appreciated.

No claim for injury to any person or damage to or loss of any property on account of fire, theft or any cause shall be made to or against the Central Florida Poultry Breeders Association or Citrus County, it's officers or agents, by or on behalf of the exhibitor.



Show Rules

1. The Central Florida Poultry Breeders Association reserves the right to substitute and/or add judges if necessary. All judge's decisions are final.
2. This poultry show is open to all Bantam, Large Fowl, Waterfowl, Turkey and Guinea breeds as defined by the APA and ABA unless permission has been obtained from the show superintendent.
3. The terms COCK (C), HEN (H), COCKEREL (K) and PULLET (P) are defined as in the APA Standard.
4. Displays and trios are not accepted at this show.
5. Birds will be judged under the rules of the ABA and APA, whichever apply.
6. Youth Showmanship will follow the Youth Exhibition Poultry Association (YEPA) rules.
7. Due to show setup timelines, all entry deadlines in this catalog will be strictly enforced.
8. The "open" show is a Double-Points show. The entry fee is \$6 per bird. The double coop entry fee is \$9 per bird. This fee covers both shows.
9. The "youth" show is a single show. The entry fee is \$3.50 per bird. The double coop entry fee is \$5 per bird. The youth showmanship fee is \$1 per showmanship participant.
10. All payments made via "PayPal" (including credit card payments, which are processed by PayPal) will be charged an additional \$0.30 per exhibitor plus \$0.20 per bird for "open" exhibitors and \$0.10 per bird for "youth" exhibitors. This is to cover the transaction fees charged by PayPal.
11. All checks and money orders are to be made payable to CFPBA.
12. All entries must be paid prior to the registration deadline unless special permission has been granted by the show secretary. This will be handled on a case-by-case basis and the Central Florida Poultry Breeders Association reserves the right to deny an entry if payment has not been made by the deadline.
13. No refunds will be given, including if an exhibitor does not show or brings less birds than entered.
14. Sale cages will be \$2 each and limited to 3 birds per cage for show exhibitors and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Non-exhibitors will be charged \$5 each. Anyone bringing a bird onto the show grounds, even if they are for sale and not being entered in the show, must follow the bio-security rules listed below.
15. Outdoor sales space will not be available for this show.
16. Indoor floor sales space will be available for \$10 for show exhibitors, \$25 for non-exhibitors. Anyone bringing a bird onto the show grounds, even if they are for sale and not being entered in the show, must follow the bio-security rules listed below.
17. Failure to check in with the State Inspectors and the Show Secretary prior to cooping in the birds may result in disqualification from the show.
18. All birds must be cooped in by 8:45 AM Saturday morning. Judging will begin promptly at 9:00 AM. Check-in is on Friday evening from 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM and on Saturday morning from 6:00 AM to 8:45 AM. No birds will be allowed to be cooped in after judging has started.
19. No one will be allowed in closed aisles during the judging except for the judges, show clerks and show staff. Please do not talk to the judges during judging, including Champion Row.
20. Do not feed or distract the birds while the judge is in that aisle.
21. The Central Florida Poultry Breeders Association will not be responsible for loss or accident to persons or their birds. However, every effort will be put forth to secure property and birds. A staff member will be present in the arena between 9:00 PM Friday night and 6:00 AM Saturday morning.
22. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the in the show building or on the show grounds. No smoking is allowed inside of or directly in front of the arena.
23. Handle only your own birds unless permission of the owner is given.
24. We ask that youth exhibitors coop and groom their own birds. If assistance from an adult is required, we ask that the youth help as much as possible. Adults may not coop in youth birds without the youth exhibitor physically present with them.
25. Anyone except for show staff caught taking birds or eggs from someone else's coop without permission will be asked to leave the premises and barred from future Central Florida Poultry Breeders Association shows.
26. No birds will be released until judging is complete and show champion is chosen. Cooping out of birds before judging is complete will be considered a disqualification.
27. Awards will be given out after the judging is complete. We ask that birds are not cooped out until the all of the awards have been given out.
28. Any matter that is not covered by show rules will be decided by the show superintendent and all decisions are final.

Bio Security Rules

1. Bio-security rules apply to all birds present on the show grounds. This includes show birds and sale birds both inside and outside of the show building.
2. All birds brought onto the show property must be Pullorum tested, even if they are not entered into the show. Florida Department of Agriculture State Inspectors will be present to inspect NPIP paperwork or to perform testing (free of charge) at check in on both Friday evening and Saturday morning. If NPIP paperwork is not present or is not valid, you will be required to have your birds tested prior to entering the show building.
3. Any birds in the show or sales cages that appear sick will be removed from the show grounds.
4. The Central Florida Poultry Breeders Association prohibits the entry of any bird that has been in or through an area under quarantine in the 60 days prior to the show.
5. All exhibitors must comply with all state poultry health regulations, statutes, guidelines and recommendations.

- Age divisions are as follows (This is the age of the exhibitor the day of the show. We follow the Youth Exhibition Poultry Association [YEPA] Sanctioning Rules.):

PEE WEE ...	7 years and under;
NOVICE ...	8-18 and never participated in showmanship
JUNIOR ...	8-10;
INTERMEDIATE ...	11-13;
SENIOR ...	14-18
- Showmanship will begin immediately after the Youth Show birds have been judged.

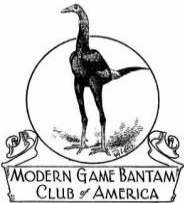

Directions to the Show

From the north:

Take I-75 south to exit 423 (SR 47 Ft White/Lake City). Make a right onto SR 47. Continue for 37.2 miles to N Main St in Trenton. Make a left and continue for 0.4 miles to SR 26/W Wade St. Make a right and continue for 7.5 miles to Co Hwy 55A (there is a sign “To Alt US 27, US 19, US 98”). Make a slight left and continue for another 0.3 miles. The Suwannee River Fair Pavilion will be on the left just before the intersection of Alt US 27/US 19/ US 98.

From the south:

If taking the Florida’s Turnpike, head north to the end and merge onto I-75. Then ...

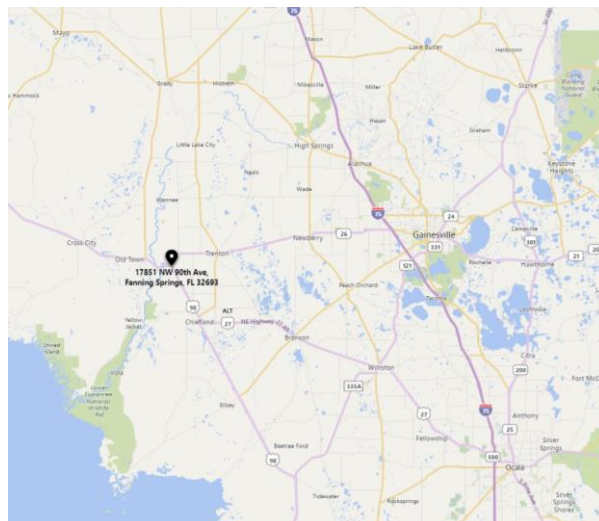

Continue straight on Alt US 27 for 26.1 miles to N main St/US 19/US 98 in Chiefland. Make a right and continue for 8.0 miles to 90 Ave. Make a right and the Suwannee River Fair Pavilion will be immediately on the right..

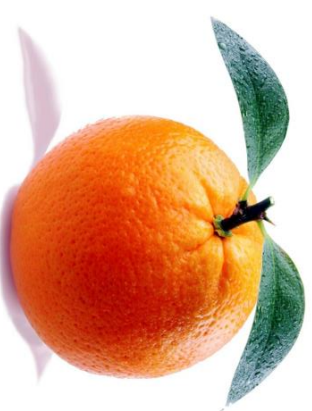
