Rules



- Entry is open to all current 4-H, FFA, and Jr Cattleman of FL or AL members.
- Entries must be received with the entry form attached or online. All mailed entries should include the registration forms and monies postmarked by August 17, 2018. Late entries will not be accepted after August 27, 2018. Entries should be made out and mailed to Escambia County 4-H Foundation, 3730 Stefani Road, Cantonment, FL 32533. 4-H Office phone: 850-475-5230, extension 2.

- All animals must be checked in and weighed in, present at the property by 10 am on September 1, 2018. Check-in/Weigh-in will be held from 8 am to 10 am on September 1, 2018.
- Special arrangements may be made for exhibitors to arrive after 4 pm on Friday. Show management must be contacted by August 27, 2018 concerning this request.
- The property is available for dry camping, although there are NO showers or dump station available. There are not hotels in Molino. Hotels are located close to I-10 off Pine Forest Road or in Atmore, AL. Hampton Inn&Suites: 850-607-7174, 8021 Lavelle Way, Pensacola, FL; Hampton Inn Atmore: 251-368-9090, 45 Rivercane Blvd West, Atmore, AL.
- Space in the cow barn is available on a first come, first serve basis. Electrical outlets are limited. Generators are highly recommended.
- All animals must be halter broken and controlled. For safety concerns, a 3 strikes and you are out system will be implemented. A three person safety team will oversee this process. The first and second warnings will be verbal, the third time the exhibitor will be asked to remove the animal and will be disqualified. The safety of our youth and animals is of the up most importance, and we want all exhibitors to have a enjoyable experience.
- Exhibitors are responsible for furnishing feed, feed bowls, and water for the entirety of the show. Bedding will not be provided, although it may be brought in. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up any site used throughout the show, including camping sites.
- No bulls or cow/calf pairs will be accepted.
- Heifers must weigh at least 400 pounds, and market ready steers should weigh a minimum of 1000 pounds. Steers weighing 999 pounds and under will be classified as a prospect steer.
- All animals will be classified at check-in/weigh-in. Animals will be divided into three categories: Brahman Influence, American Influence, or English Influence, then into weight categories based on influence.
- All animals must have a current health certificate which will be needed to check-in/weigh-in.
- This is a Blow & Go Show (No Fit Show). All animals will be exhibited at owner's own risk and in their natural state, clean and clipped. No aerosols, paints, glues, etc. are allowed. Animals should be shown clean and dry. Animals are subject to being checked with a cloth in the make-up area. Failure to comply with the rules will result in disqualification.
- One show shirt will be provided for each paid exhibitor. The t-shirts should be worn as a part of their show day attire. Full show attire should include show t-shirt, jeans, closed toed shoes/boots. Additional shirts may be purchased with registration or the day of (supply limited).
