IMPORTANT CATTLE REGISTRATION INFO!

Please refer to angus.org under NJAA guidelines for rules on exhibiting Angus cattle. We will be following these rules for our field day.

Please make sure your angus registration papers are in the youth's name that will be showing the animal. Please be sure that the angus cattle are tattooed in both ears and it matches the registration paper.

All bulls 12 months of age or older must have a nose ring in place with lead attached to participate in the bull show. Cattle that cannot be handled will not be permitted to participate. **Bulls must be bred and owned to show!**

All Junior member lunches are included with entry fee.
All Non-member adult and youth lunches are \$10.00.

All Showmanship, Grand Champion, and Reserve Grand Champion winners will have pictures taken immediately following each Grand Champion drive.

Please make sure the area you used is cleaned up prior to your departure! Please pick up all the hay, garbage and waste in your stall area. If the exhibitor's stall is not cleaned before their departure there will be a fine of \$40.00. This fine will go towards the extra fees charged by the facility when stalls and arena are left dirty.
