**START TIMES:** Show will begin at 9:00 PM with Showmanship, Wethers, Does, and Bucks.

**ENTRY FEES:** \$8.00 per class for FPGA Members.

\$9.00 per class for NON-FPGA Members

No charge for Showmanship.

All fees are non-refundable and must accompany the entry form. Base date for computing each animal's age is the date of the show (February 15, 2019). All entries **MUST BE RECEIVED** by February 1, 2019.

**JUDGE:** **Jill Conklin**

**NOTE:** No goats with herd name of either judge can be exhibited under that judge. An exhibitor shall not present an animal to be shown under a judge that has an ownership or part ownership or by a member of his/her immediate family or household.

**HEALTH RULES:** All goats are required to be accompanied by an official **health certificate**. Only animals with valid health certificates will be allowed on the grounds. All goats must meet health requirements as specified in the Rules for Exhibition as required by the Florida Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services. An accredited state veterinarian will be checking animals **before** allowing entry to the fairgrounds. Out of state exhibitors are required to check health paper requirements before entering the state.

**SHOW RULES:** The Breed Standards and Show Rules of NPGA shall govern and be upheld at this show. [www.NPGA-pygmys.com](http://www.NPGA-pygmys.com)

- An original Registration Certificate or approved duplicate is required for all animals six months of age or older. An original certificate or a stamped duplicate, or faxed stamped duplicate application showing the date of receipt by the registry office, is required on animals under six months of age.
- Certificates (or duplicates if applicable) must be presented to the Show Secretary for verification before the judging begins.
- An animal winning Champion or Reserve Champion must have a legible tattoo or microchip (owner must provide reader) that matches the Certificate/Application or the exhibitor will forfeit their award.

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- Proof of ownership shall be the name on the Certificate or Application. Persons showing an animal who's Certificate or Application have signed transfers on them must show those animals as agent for the owner on the Certificate or Application.
- Substitution is permitted. Substitution **has to be made before** end of check-in to show.
- Classes and/or Divisions may be combined or divided with the permission of the Show Chairman and judge on show day.
- Animals with natural horns, disbudded, or dehorned may be shown without regard to discrimination.
- The judge's decision will be final. No protest will be allowed. No reversal of decision will be considered.
- No designated grooming area.

**AWARDS:** Presented to 1st through 5th places. Champion Rosettes will be awarded to Best & Reserve Best Wethers and to NPGA Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Does and Bucks.

**AUCTION:** A silent auction will be held. Please bring items to help support the show and club. Any donation will be greatly appreciated.

**PEN DÉCOR:** Everyone is encouraged to decorate pens in the Winter Summerland theme!

## **Youth Show Rules 2019**

### **(Show will start after a short break after Open Show)**

- Any goat that is shown in the youth show must be registered in the child's name, family name/family herd name.
- Youth must be dressed appropriately; Attire of the youth should represent pride for the club and for their animal.
- Youth exhibitors are expected to be respectful of the judge and fellow exhibitors (NO CELL PHONE usage will be permitted during the youth show)
- No horse play in barn while show is on going.
- Youth must have animal ready when class is called, there will be no entry after gate is closed.
- Youth must be prepared and knowledgeable about what class and age group in which their goat belongs.
- Each youth must compete in proper age group.
- Youth must show good sportsmanlike conduct.
- All judges selections are final.

**YOUTH AWARDS:** We will have Awards/Prizes for the youth show and showmanship. We will also have awards for the Best Overall Pen for the decorating contest and an award for the Best Poster in each age category.
