**ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS:** Complete your entry form online. Complete the entry form and check to be sure that you haven't skipped any sections, upload each of your cattle's registration papers online, and pay online.

### **A Note To Parents About Your Child's Personal Information:**

Why do we require personal information and social security numbers? We understand your concerns, and we want you to know why this info is needed. Many of our 4-H and FFA youths take part in various contests and events-rabbits, poultry, dog show, horse show, and other open and youth shows. It is possible our kids can earn multiple premiums and accumulate a sum of money that requires us to report their earnings to the IRS. It would be difficult to contact parents after the fair to get the information needed and still get checks written and to the winners in a

timely manner. We want you to know their information is guarded and entry forms are shredded when they are no longer needed.

**NOTICE:** In the case of papers pending, it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to provide the fair with a letter from the breed association stating that the papers on their animal have been applied for but have not yet been processed. Papers pending will not be accepted without this letter from the association.

**Rules:**

1. Exhibitors must adhere to the requirements as outlined in the Youth General Livestock Rules and Regulations.
2. Exhibitors must show their own animal(s).
3. 4-H and F.F.A. exhibitors entering the Youth Beef Show or the Youth Dairy Show will be required to be clean, neat, and dressed in white, green, blue or black jeans or slacks, whichever is appropriate, with a solid white shirt or white polo shirt with white collar. 4-H accessories are strongly recommended. Closed-toed shoes or boots are required. T-shirts, caps or hats are prohibited. If you are an F.F.A. member, show dress is required.

**Beef Showmanship:**

Beef Showmanship will be at the beginning of the Youth Beef Show. All bulls intended to be shown in the showmanship class must be shown with a permanent or temporary nose ring.

If you wish to compete for Showmanship, you must indicate this on your registration form.

**Showmanship Awards:**

First Place Division Winners in Youth Beef Showmanship will be presented with a belt buckle award sponsored by The Duval County Cattlemen's Association. Awards will be presented Saturday, November 3rd, at 7:00 p.m. during the Parade of Champions. Second and third place winners in each division will receive an award.

**Eligibility:**

Restricted to bona fide 4-H and FFA members as of September 1st, of the current year.

Junior.....8 - 10 Years of age

Intermediate.....11 - 13 Years of age

Senior.....14 - 18 Years of age

F.F.A. Junior Division will be comprised of middle / junior high students.

F.F.A. Senior Division will be comprised of senior high students.

**Cattle will be received:**

Tuesday, October 30th, from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Wednesday, October 31st, from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon.

All animals entered in the Greater Jacksonville Agricultural Fair MUST have a current health certificate.

**All cattle entering the Youth Beef Show must be received when all other youth cattle are received.**

**Release:**

Youth cattle will be released after 9:00 p.m. Saturday, November 3rd. Animals remaining to show in a specific Open Breed Show will be released when those breeds are released. See the Youth General Rules for additional information on the release policy and release map.

### Youth Beef Herdsman Award:

There is no other class of livestock, which requires a greater attention to neatness, cleanliness, and sanitation, as does the exhibit of cattle. Realizing that the herdsman is directly responsible for the condition of his herd and the quarters it occupies, this award should be an incentive to the herdsman and should add greatly to the appearance of the barns. All persons in charge of herds shall be considered entrants in this contest.

The following will serve as a score card for the Youth Beef Show Herdsman Award:

1. Condition and cleanliness of herd or flock: 25 Points
2. Attractiveness of exhibit: 20 Points
3. Neatness and cleanliness of herdsman or shepherd: 15 Points
4. Courtesy of herdsman or shepherd: 10 Points
5. Cleanliness of stalls: 10 Points
6. Cleanliness of aisles: 10 Points
7. General Cooperation: 10 Points

**Total: 100 Points**

### Parking Passes and Admission:

Tickets for gate admission and parking passes for Lot #3 will be distributed when exhibitors check-in at the Livestock Office. Each Youth Beef Exhibitor will be given nine (9) daily admission tickets and one (1) parking pass, which will cover the three (3) days they are exhibiting at the Greater Jacksonville Agricultural Fair to be used by the exhibitor and parents. If there is more than one exhibitor from the same family, the second exhibitor from that family will receive three (3) daily admission tickets and the third family member who is exhibiting will also receive three (3) daily admission tickets and one (1) parking pass, which will cover the three (3) days that they are exhibiting.

**Note:** An admission ticket will be for a single day. Be sure to utilize your tickets to cover every day you are at the fair. There will be no additional tickets issued. If additional tickets are required, you may purchase them for half price (\$5.00) from the Livestock Office or the Administration Office. Additional tickets may also be bought online for half price before the fair opens on October 31st, 2018.
