

## **New Year's Swine Showdown**

**2019**

### **General Rules**

1. All animals must be checked in from 6:30-9:00 am on Saturday January 5, 2019.
2. Showmanship will start at 10:30 am. The crossbred and purebred and Florida bred shows will follow.
3. The show is open to anyone up to the age of 21 (as of 9/1/18), from any state. Out of state youth are permitted to show, however, only FJSC members will accumulate points for the series.
4. Approximately 100 pens will be available on a first come, first served basis. You are allowed to show off of your trailer
5. The pens provided are on concrete. Shavings will be allowed as bedding (not provided)
6. Exhibitors must clean their pens before leaving the show.
7. All swine must have health papers at the time of unloading. All out of state swine must also have a Florida permit number on the health paper. All health papers must be issued with 90 days of January 5, 2019.
8. It is recommended that all swine be vaccinated against Leptospirosis including Bratislava and erysipelas.
9. There is no limit on the number of animals you can show.
10. Power is limited. Generators are allowed outside of the barn.
11. All pigs must have a readable ear tag.
12. Substitutions will be accepted the day of the show.
13. Showmanship is open to anyone. You may use someone else's hog, with their permission.
14. All exhibitors must be neatly dressed.
15. Official dress is not required.
16. Hog classes will be split by weight.
17. Barrows and gilts only, no boars will be allowed.
18. The judge's decision is final.
19. Show officials reserve the right to make changes deemed to be in the best interest of the show.
20. All animals must be removed 2 hours following the conclusion of the show.
21. The exhibitor and a parent/legal guardian must sign all entry forms.
22. The show committee, The Wrangler Alumni, nor The Central Florida Fair will be responsible for any accidents or injuries at the show.

23. The show committee, the Wrangler 4H, nor the Central Florida Fair will be responsible for any lost or stolen personal items or damages to property.
24. Showmanship ages are as follows (as of 9/1/18):
- a. Novice: 8 and under
  - b. Junior: 8-12
  - c. Intermediate: 13-16
  - d. Senior: 17-21
25. Entry Fees are as follows:
- a. \$25 per entry postmarked by 12/28/19
  - b. Late fee of \$10 per animal for any entry postmarked later than 12/28/18 or paid day of show
  - c. Entries will be accepted at the show, exact cash only
  - d. Showmanship fee is \$10 per exhibitor
  - e. All entries are non-refundable
26. The New Year's Swine Show will run under the Florida Junior Swine Circuit rules.
