SHOW RULES

NPGA rules will govern all NPGA classes. Per NPGA show rules, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to make sure that their animals are entered in the correct classes. *Please do not send in entry forms without class numbers listed for your goats.* Any NPGA animal over 6 months of age must be tattooed or microchipped prior to being shown in a sanctioned NPGA class or wether class according to NPGA show rules. All goats entered in the NPGA sanctioned classes must be accompanied by their NPGA registration certificates. Registered wethers should also have their registration certificates accompanying them. Unregistered wethers can be shown in the wether classes. Goats bearing the judge's herdname may not be shown under that judge.

ENTRIES

Entry fees are \$9.00 per goat/per class. Please make checks payable to Southwest Florida & Lee County Fair (no charge for showmanship or youth fun show.) ***Entry deadline to be included in the showbook is Friday, November 30th, 2018.*** Substitutions and late entries will not be included in the printed program. Age computation for classes is based on the age of the goat on the date of the show.

PENS

Pens will be provided for this show at \$8.00 each. If you are planning to come, even if you are just thinking of coming, we need your pen requirements by November 3. We ask that each exhibitor clean their pens at the end of the show or we will accept a \$10 donation per pen to the local Goats-R-Us 4H club to clean them for you. **You may also show out of your trailer for no charge.**

CHECK IN and ARRIVAL TIME

Animals may arrive any time after 5:00 PM on Friday, December 7th or Saturday morning from 7:00-8:00am. Check-in will begin Friday from 5:00-6:00 PM and Saturday 7:00-8:00 AM.

HEALTH PAPERS/RESTRICTIONS

All goats shall be accompanied by an official **health certificate.** Only animals with valid health certificates will be allowed on the grounds. All goats must meet health requirements as specified in the Rules for Exhibition as required by the Florida Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services. Out of state exhibitors should check health paper requirements before entering the state. An accredited state veterinarian will be checking animals **before** they are allowed to enter the fairgrounds.

SPONSORSHIPS

We welcome any sponsorship of the classes in the show. You may sponsor any number of classes for \$5.00 each. You get a free business card ad in the showbook with each class sponsored. **We will also be printing any farm name or business name on the back of our show shirts that sponsors a gift basket for the auction OR a min. of \$50 sponsorship.**

MEALS

We will have a local 4-H club there cooking lunch for a small donation to help kids get to Washington D.C. for 4-H Congress.

We will be holding a silent auction and 50/50 raffle. We would greatly appreciate any donations you would be able to make. **People wanting to donate Gift Baskets for the auction will have their farm name or business name printed on the back of the show shirts.**

HOTELS/LODGING

RV/CAMPING – RV hook-ups are available at the fairgrounds. The fee is \$30/night. Advance notice and payment is required. Please contact Darren Watkins if you plan on needing this service.

There are numerous hotels available in the area. It is recommended to book your hotel as soon as possible.

SHOW T-SHIRTS

We will be ordering “Romp in the Swamp” T-Shirts for the show. The cost of these shirts is \$20 each and will be printed on a dry fit shirt. Please let Darren know how many and what sizes are needed by November 23rd so we can order them.

We will also be printing any farm name or business name on the back of our show shirts that sponsors a gift basket for the auction OR a min. of \$50. Anyone that wants to sponsor (either gift basket or \$50) let Darren know by Oct 21 due to printing of the shirts.

Youth Show Rules 2018

- Any goat that is shown in the youth show must be registered in the child’s name, family name/family herd name.
- Youth must be dressed appropriately; Attire of the youth should represent pride for the club and for their animal.
- Youth exhibitors are expected to be respectful of the judge and fellow exhibitors (NO CELL PHONE usage will be permitted during the youth show)
- No horse play in barn while show is ongoing.
- Youth must have animal ready when class is called, there will be no entry after gate is closed.
- Youth must be prepared and knowledgeable about what class and age group in which their goat belongs.
- Each youth must compete in proper age group.
- Youth must show good sportsmanlike conduct.
- All judges’ selections are final.

Exhibitor covenants and agrees to fully exonerate, indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Southwest Florida and Lee County Fair Association, Inc., its Board of Directors, officers, management, staff, agents, employees, and representatives and the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County, Florida, along with its employees, staff, agents and representatives, individually, jointly, and collectively, from any and all claims, suits, losses, damages, judgments, fines, penalties, liabilities, expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees and costs, in all administrative proceedings and/or at the trial and appellate level and/or pre-suit, for any injury or death to persons and/or any loss of or damage to property caused by, growing out of, or arising out of User's use of the Facility, including, without limitation, its use by User's agents, attendees (invited or otherwise), sub-licensees, vendors, or concessionaires; exercise of any rights under the Agreement; breach of any term, warranty or provision of this Agreement by User; the sale of products or any act or omission of User, its employees, officers, or agents. User hereby waives entitlement, if any, to immunity under Section 440.11, Florida Statutes. Such indemnification shall not apply to injury to persons or damage to property arising out of the Fair Association's gross negligence or willful misconduct. The obligations contained in this provision shall survive termination of this Agreement and shall not be limited by the amount of any insurance required to be obtained or maintained under this Agreement. Nothing contained herein shall be construed to be a waiver of any immunity or limitation of liability the Fair Association and/or the Board of County Commissioners may have under the doctrine of sovereign immunity or Section 768.28, Florida Statutes.

I understand that I am responsible for the welfare and security of myself, my family, my animals and all my personal belongings. I agree to have the Florida Health committee to inspect my goats for illness and allow them to dismiss if any deemed unhealthy or at risk.
