Santa Fe Showdown Beef Rules & Regulations:

- 1.) Brahman influence classes will be formed with a minimum entry of 15 head.
- 2.) Fitting and Grooming allowed. However, all clipping and fitting must be done at your trailer. **No clipping in the barn.**
- 3.) All bulls 12 months and older must be shown with a nose lead.
- 4.) Show order as follows (Following showmanship) Steers, Heifers, Cow/Calf, and Bulls.
- 5.) If a Cow/Calf pair is entered, the pair must be shown together. Neither can be entered in any separate categories.
- 6.) Cow/Calf pairs must either have a calf on the ground or be verified pregnant by veterinarian.

2019 Santa Fe Showdown General Rules & Regulations:

- 1) Separate entry for each exhibitor is required.
- 2) Safety and respect for all participants and guests is to be demonstrated at all times. Exhibitors or guests who are not demonstrating good behavior may be disqualified and asked to leave by the show officials at any time for violating safety and/or respect policies.
- 3) Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after themselves and their property.
- 4) All animals must be properly tagged or tattooed.
- 5) All classes will be divided by weight (determined by show officials). After all animals are entered; classes will be determined.
- 6) All exhibitors participating in showmanship must show their own animals.
- 7) No entries will be refunded
- 8) There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor can show.
- 9) Current health papers are required at check in. No unloading will be permitted without visual inspection by a veterinarian.
- 10) If an animal shows safety concerns while in the ring, the judge or show officials have the right to remove the exhibitor/animal at any time. Safety is our number one priority.
- 11) No dogs/pets allowed on the premises.
- 12) No generators inside the barn or arena and No electrical devices in the wash rack.
- 13) Grooming chutes are limited to one per exhibitor. Grooming chutes must be confined to the area you and your cattle are parked at.
- 14) Check in will be from 7:00 AM to 9:30 AM. NO LATE CHECK IN IS PERMITTED
- 15) Showmanship begins at 12 PM for cattle in the following order: peewee (age 1-7), Junior (age 8-11), Intermediate (age 12-14) Senior (age 15-18 not graduated from high school)

Tie outs will be to your trailer on a first come first serve basis, you are responsible for bringing your own shade and power.
