- Show will be at the Escambia County 4-H property, 5681 Chalker Road Molino, FL 32577.
- Check-in and weigh-in is from 8am-10am on Saturday morning October 6, 2018.
- Animals can be brought to the property on Friday afternoon after 2pm October 5, 2018.
- Health papers will be required.
- Steers and heifers will be shown in weight classes.
- Heifers must be born on or after October 1, 2016. Steers must be born after January 1, 2017
- No cow/calf pairs.
- Fitting is encouraged but not mandatory.
- Showmanship will begin at 11am: one Junior class ages 8-10, one Intermediate class ages 11-13, and one Senior class ages 14-18. Exhibitor must show their entered steer or heifer in the showmanship class.
- Showmanship class winners will receive prizes. Age as of the day of show.
- \$500 for grand champion heifer, \$250 for reserve champion heifer along with buckles.
- \$250 for grand champion steer and \$150 for reserve champion steer along with buckles (Prize money may be higher depending on number of entries).
- Steer show starts at 1pm. Heifer show to follow.
- Lunch will be sold on site.
- All participants must fill out an entry form signed by a parent or guardian and mailed with a \$30 entry fee. All entry forms must be received before September 29, 2018. Late registration will be \$40.
- Participate is responsible for feeding and watering animals and cleaning up barns after leaving.
- All animals must be tied with a halter and neck rope.
- Open to any youth 8-18 or registered in 4-H or FFA.
- Generators are preferred, but electricity is offered on a first come, first served basis in barns.
- Stand along camping is available.
- Payments can be mailed to Chad Ward: P.O. Box 602 Cantonment, FL 32533.
- Show superintendents are Chad Ward 850-393-6223 and Scott Ward 850-554-9891.
- Protests will be \$200 and must be presented to the show superintendents within 1 hour of the show. All monies put forth for a protest, will be forfeited if a participant loses a protest.
