

## **GOAT SHOW SCHEDULE AND RULES**

Date and Schedule: Saturday, January 5, 2018

Check-in: 7:00am to 9:30am Show starts at 10:00am

Market goats must be weighed in during check-in prior to start of the show.

Entries: Early entry deadline: December 21, 2018 (postmarked date)

December 22, 2018 to day of entries: \$25.00 each

General Rules: The Winter Classic at the Coast is open to exhibitors from the State of Florida and out of

State. The show is open to all age exhibitors. Exhibitors under the age of 6 must be

accompanied by a handler in the ring.

This is a tie-out show. Stalls and electricity are not provided. Bringing your own shade and generator is recommended. Stalls and electricity are available in the horse barns for \$35.00 per stall that is to be paid at check-in and stall will be assigned and electricity turned on. Camper hookups are also available for \$35.00 per night.

The show chairman and committee reserve the final right to interpret these rules, settle and determine all matters and questions arising from or connected to the Winter Classic on the Coast. Any exhibitor who violates the rules will forfeit all privileges and such penalties as the committee may deem reasonable.

An official certificate of veterinary inspection must be presented at time of check-in dated within 90 days [within 30 days for out of state animals] of show.

The exhibitor is liable for any damages his/her goat may incur and also for the safety of his/her goats. Winter Classic on the Coast assumes no responsibility or liability for any damages. If any goat is a threat to the public the animal will be removed from the show area. Poor sportsmanship [as determined by the show committee] will not be tolerated. The judge's decision is final and should be respected.

Show Rules: Meat does and bucks, dairy does and bucks, and dwarf goat shows will be shown by age

and broken into separate classes. Class scheduled is reflected on the following page. Market goats will be shown by weight and will be weighed at check-in. Market goats must be 12 months and under and still have their milk teeth. List of classes will be posted after check-in. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champions will be awarded. Showmanship will be divided into peewee [7 and under], junior [8-II], intermediate [12-I4], senior [15-I8, has not graduated High School] and adult divisions [has graduated High School and older].

There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor may enter in the show. A minimum of IO animals are required to have each division. The show committee reserves the right to combine or split classes as necessary.
